


This talk was aimed at providing students with a broad understanding of IPR, especially in the Indian context.

Dr.Sadashivaiah, Assistant Professor, Department of Molecular Biology, Yuvaraja's College, Mysuru introduced the speaker to the audience. Dr. Krishnainter acted with the students for a few minutes before the talk to understand their perspectives on the topic.

Dr.KrishnabeganhistalkwithanoverviewofIPs,theirfeatures,andtheirtypes.Hethenexplainedeach type of IP and its applications in detail. For eachtype of IP, he used interesting case studies to help students understand better. He stressed the differences between IPR in India and other countries and also included a section that dealt with filing an IP step by step in India and abroad. He engaged the audience with his interactive style of presentation by displaying questions on the slide and encouraging

the audience to try and come up with answers based on his explanation. The audience responded well andwereabletoanswermostofhisprompt-based questions which is a good indicator that the concepts were imbibed in them.
