<u>Report of the Blood Donation Camp organized by YCMAA, NSS and NCC on 13-12-2022</u> <u>between 8 am and 1.30 pm at Health Centre, Yuvaraja, Maharaja College Campus</u>

The camp began at 9 am. Prof.Somashekarappa, Administrative Officer, YCM, Prof.K.B.Umesh, Cntroller of Examination, YCM, Prof.N.S Devaki, Coordinator IQAC, Dr.M.S.Basavaraj, Chief Medical Officer, inaugurated the camp.Shri Surendranath, Retd. Colonel Indian Army who is an aumni of our college was present for the inauguration of the camp. He was the first person to donate blood. Later on registration of the students were being managedby Dr. Lokesh Gowda and Dr.Abdul Haleem Quraishi.

A street play was organized by NSS and NCC coordinators on 7-12-22 between 10 to 10.30 am and 1.30 to 2.30 pm to build awareness on the importance of blood donation. As a result around 250 students registered themselves voluntarily to donate blood.

Dr.Pallavi, Pathologist J.S.S Hospitals coordinated the camp on behalf of J.S.S Hospital Out of 250 registrations; only 80 students could donate blood on 13-12-22 as Dr.Pallavi said they manage the camp based on the storage and stocks available at their hospital. 30% of the blood donated was provided to K.R.Hospital, and handed over to the staff of K.R. hospital who were also part of the camp. J.S.S hospital provided Juice, biscuits and certificate to the students. YCMAA provided banana's to the students who donated blood. Smt.Poornima, City Head HDFC Bank and Shri Manu, Manager HDFC Bank, Saraswathipuram branch were present at the camp and provided 'thermos flask' for the students who donated blood.
