The Principal of the college is requested to present Action Plan along with budgetary requirements for five years as per XII Plan CPE guidelines for the next phase before the Expert Committee in its Interface meeting. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the above meeting.



It was also observed during the interface meetings that certain colleges are still working as 'Composite College'. In such cases, the CPE funds should be used only for the degree/P.G. programmes and not for the "+2" programme. In this connection, an undertaking in an affidavit that the funds so provided under the scheme will not be used for the Junior College, i.e. 10+1 and 10+2 classes.

It is further to inform you that you have to registered your college account in PFMS system under UGC Scheme code 0875 with documentary evidence.

In this regard, kindly submit the above required documents at the earliest to enable this office to release admissible grant to your college under the Scheme.
