

Feedback Analysis Report for the year 2021-2022

Importance of Student Feedback:

The College aims to offer the best possible environment and learning experience to encourage students to perform to their full potential. Feedback from students allows the College to evaluate how its service provision is viewed by its most important group of stakeholders, namely its students. Besides providing students with an opportunity to comment on the quality of the teaching and learning environment at the College, feedback ensures that lecturers and Boards of Studies are made aware of problems perceived or encountered by students, and provides an opportunity for the conduct of self-evaluation and revision, where necessary.

How are Student/Alumni/Stake holders Feedback obtained and analysed ?

The feedback system is considered an important tool for counter-checking of the performance of various parameters collected from students, alumni, faculty, and parents in order to ensure and analyze academic excellence. **Students feedback are obtained during class hours regarding the curriculum design, about the program, about the facilities available in the college.** Parents Feedback is obtained during their visit to the department, Teachers feedback obtained during regular staff meetings and Alumni feedback obtained notifying it in the college website. All these feedbacks are obtained raising the google form and uploading the google form in the college website and giving publicity. A scale of 4 is used to evaluate each parameter, giving weightage for excellent is 4 and for fair is 1. MS Excel is used to analyse the data. All graphs are computed from excel sheet with data sourced from the google form.

Methodology adopted to obtain feedback from the students:

- (2) The completeness of the individual study-units of their choice.
- (3) The facilities available in the college.






2. Teacher fulfilment to student aspiration








5. Teacher involvement in class/lab

Detailed results of the assessment obtained are displayed in the bar graph shown below. From the bar chart it can be observed that 66.90 percent weightage is given to the standard of the syllabus which has been framed keeping in view the progression of the students. Of the total, 66.20% weightage has been given to the teachers' involvement in class/lab. The steady increase in the enrolment of the students to various courses being offered by the college warrants better lab facilities and a larger number of equipments, as can be made out from 64.83% and 61.05% respectively.

Overall feedback analysis

The various graphs present the different views expressed by Alumni with regard to their perception on the quality of the educational institution. Most of the Alumni rated campus environment as excellent. Dissatisfaction expressed by the alumni as made out from some of the ratings of the parameters has been noted and suitable measures will be adopted to address the grievances. Over all 80.97 % of the participants are happy with the performance and development of the college and marked good or satisfactory. Job and placement cells need to be strengthened and the college has already taken steps to interact with the industries for in house training and better placement opportunities.

The result is placed before the college council and measures are discussed to improve where the college is lacking and also improve the existing infrastructure.

















































The results of the assessment obtained are displayed in the bar graph shown below.

From the bar chart it can be seen that 100.00 percent of the weightage is given to Vision & objectives of the college which is well known, followed by 75 percent of the weightage is given to Program outcome, Well defined syllabus, Good academic flexibility, Fulfillment of the need of students, Medical facility to handle all types emergencies, Clean drinking water, laboratory equipment's, computer facilities and students motivated by teachers in the college and 50 percent weightage is given to approachability of faculties and appreciation of individual achievement. 25 percent weightage is given to aims and objectives, student discipline, opportunity for continuous development, equal opportunity for all staff, rest room and toilets, conservation of environment,

mechanism for feedback and progress of the college over the year.

The steady increase in the enrolment of the students to various courses being offered by the college and huge number of teachers working in the college requires that Rest rooms, toilets, laboratory, playground, classrooms are clean and well maintained. The Institute has taken action to improve the basic facilities in the coming years.
