Yuvaraja's college a constituent college of University of Mysore invites application from eligible students who have passed PUC or Equivalent in the prescribed form for admission to the FIVE YEAR INTEGRATED M.Sc. in MOLECULAR BIOLOGY Program for the year 2021-2022.

Eligibility:

Candidates who have completed two-year Pre University course of Karnataka state or 10+2 or equivalent with science subjects as optionals and have secured at least 45% average marks in the optional papers (5% relaxation for SC/ST) with a minimum of 45% marks in Biology.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

3. The candidate seeking admission to 5-Year Integrated M.Sc. course in Molecular Biology shall have to appear for Entrance Examination to be held on 12.10.2021 4. The filled-in application form in all respects along with necessary certificates and copies of marks cards as given below should be submitted/Posted to the Course

Coordinator, Department of Molecular Biology, Yuvaraja's College, Mysore – 570 005 on or before 01.10.2021 at 5:00PM.

5. The downloaded application form should be attached with a DD for Rs. 500/drawn from any nationalized Bank in favour of "Principal, Yuvaraja's College, Mysuru" along with other necessary documents as given below:

- a. Two Passport size colour photographs (Paste one photograph in the application form) and attach One photograph in a small cover.
- b. A demand draft (DD) for Rs. 500/- drawn from any nationalized Bank in favour of "Principal, Yuvaraja's College, Mysuru" has to be attached.

- c. Attested copy of II PUC marks card (Internet copy /Provisional marks card),
- d. Attested Copy of SSLC Marks card
- e. Caste/Category/income certificate in case of claim

6. Those students who have studied 11th & 12th std under CBSE, ICSE scheme and other than karnataka pre-university examination board students are required to produce the eligibility certificate issued by the university of Mysore, Mysuru at the time of counselling cum admission.

7. Entrance Examination: A compulsory Entrance examination is conducted in the college itself to the students seeking admission to the 5 Year integrated M.Sc. Molecular Biology program. Date and details regarding applying and admissions are as follows:

8. Entrance Examination is conducted for a maximum of 50 marks. 50 Multiple choice questions (MCQs) with 1 mark for each question (Question paper contains 30 questions from Biology, 10 Questions from Chemistry and 5 Questions from Physics and 5 questions from Mathematics)

09. Merit list will be prepared by taking 50% of the marks scored in the optional subjects in the qualifying examination (PUC/10+2/equivalent) and the marks scored out of 50 obtained in the Entrance examination

10. Entrance examination syllabus is based on the PUC/10+2/equivalent syllabus content and it is uploaded in the website

11. Following original documents are to be submitted at the time of Counseling cum Admission.

a. S.S.L.C. Original Marks Card.

b. P.U.C. Original (if not issued submit Provisional Marks Card).

- c. Caste and Income Certificates as per the recent Government Order and issued by competent authority or Valid Certificate
- d. Transfer Certificate.
- e. Aadhar card and one Passport sized Photo

12. In case the seat is not available in Scheme A as per merit and reservation policy and if it is available in Scheme B (Partially Self Financing Scheme PSFS), then the student can take seat under Scheme-B which is also based the merit order. Hence at the time of counseling the student is advised to come prepared with fee of Scheme A and Scheme B.

13. During counselling if a student accepts the seat and happens to reject the same before the payment of admission fee, then to get back the original documents a processing fee of Rs. 300/- has to be paid.

15. Fee once paid at the time of admission or any other time is non-refundable. any request in this regard will not be entertained.

16. All the original documents should be produced at the time of admission failing which the allotted seat will be cancelled. Admission of candidates to the course is subject to the provisions of Mysore University Students' (Disciplinary Control) Ordinance, 1989.

17. Under Scheme 'A' and 'B', SC, ST & Cat. I students whose Parent's annual Income is Rs.2.50 Lakhs and below and other category including GM, IIA, IIIA & IIIB whose Parent's annual Income is Rs. 1,00,000/- and below (Mysore University and other

University Students within Karnataka) are exempted from Payment of Tuition, Sports, Library, Laboratory and Examination fee fixed for the Course admitted.

18. Further, for any reasons if the students fail to receive the benefit from the Social Welfare department / Govt. of Karnataka / Govt. of India, that such students shall have to remit the prescribed fee in full.

19. The SC/ST & Cat. I candidates whose parent's annual income is above Rs.2.5 lakhs that such students have to apply scholarship and receive the benefit from the Social Welfare department / Govt. of Karnataka / Govt. of India and instruct such candidates to pay full fee on-par with general students without fail.

20. The admission fees for the year 2021-22 under Scheme A and Scheme B is uploaded in the college website.

21. Those students who are in need of Hostel accommodation have to follow the orders of University of Mysore, Mysuru.

22. Regarding the admission process, the decision of the college admission committee is final.
