

Yuvaraja's College, Mysore, is a general degree college located at Mysore, Karnataka. It was established in the year 1928. It is one of the four constituent colleges of University of Mysore. This college offers different undergraduate and postgraduate courses in science. This is one of the most distinctive features the college, whose details are given below in brief.


III Knowledge is power (Exposure to Knowledge)

The college is distinguishable in conducting various programmes for the benefit of the teachers and students. Yuvaraja's College caters education with majority of the programs being science based. It encourages academic activities through several seminars, conferences and lectures. One can see these activities throughout the year. The idea to have such *off-the-regular-class activities* is to expose the students to knowledge other than text books and initiate them to knowledge-oriented world outside. They are all part of students' centric training efforts. 
Explanation for non-German speakers:









