Our students have excelled at the National Youth Festival held during March 2024 and have brought laurels to the college and to the University.

TALENT SEARCH PROGRAMME COMMITTEE REPORT 2023-24

It gives me immense pleasure to write a report on the achievements of the students who have participated and excelled in various competitions throughout the academic year 2023-24.

Talent search programme for the academic year 2023-24 was held in our college during 27th, 28th and 29th November 2023.

A total of 26 competitions were held in various categories of arts, dance, drama, music and literary events which included both group events as well as individual events. Nearly 400 students were registered for this talent search programme out of which 129 students were declared as winners in the top three positions in each of the 26 competitions.

Among these winners a strong contingent of 34 students was selected to represent the college in the University level Intercollegiate Competitions, held during 5th, 6th and 7th of February 2024 at Manasagangotri, University of Mysore, Mysuru. In these competitions our students competed with students from 110 colleges of University of Mysore and fared exceedingly well in all categories. We missed the overall championship trophy by two points and were declared as **FIRST RUNNERS-UP**. The most commendable feature was that when the university competitions were being held in Feb 2024, the final exams of the odd semester were in full swing. In spite of the examination stress our students gave a tough competition and were declared as first runners-up.

As a result, 15 students from our college were selected to participate and represent University of Mysore in the South-East Zone Youth festival in the events of quiz, one act play, Indian and western group song singing competitions, held during 22nd to 26th Feb 2024 at SJCE campus, Mysuru. Here our students had to compete with their counterparts from other universities of Karnataka, Chhattisgarh and Telangana. Yuvaraja's college students created history by winning **gold medals** in the following two group events for the very first time which in itself is a record

(i) Quiz competition (3 participants)

(ii) Western group song singing competition (5 participants)

This stupendous performance of our college students propelled University of Mysore to win the **OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY** at the South-East zone youth festival.

The gold medal winning eight students of our college represented University of Mysore at the National Youth Festival held at Ludhiana Punjab during 28th March to 1st April 2024.

Our singing team won the third position in the Western group song singing competition at the All India level National youth Festival which is again a first of its kind.

Our students have also won the first place in the group song category in the "Smt. Padmaja Prasad Memorial Intercollegiate singing competition" held on 2nd April 2024 at Maharaja's College, Mysore.

The event was organised under IQAC by YCM Alumni Association after the approval in the Executive Committee meeting of YCMAA on 1.1.2024 held at 11.00AM . A circular was sent to all departments and a Flyer was shared in Electronic media to different colleges also. 238 participants got the benefit of GATE Exam: A Bunch of Opportunities Open in Biology.

Dr. Nikhil R. Gandasy began his workshop by asking few questions to the students. He asked “how many are aware of GATE examination” . Around 30 students responded yes. But rest of them were not having the knowledge. Dr Nikhil gave the scope of qualifying GATE examination. He informed the audience that students get qualified through percentile system and thus each year the qualifying marks will vary. Around 60000 Students generally take this examination and around 5000 get qualified. But good ranking is required for getting the eligibility to enter into reputed institutes. GATE score is the gateway for admissions in National University of Singapore and many research institutes of Germany. In addition to this a good GATE score also gives the qualified candidates an opportunity to enter into Public Sector undertakings of our countries. Dr Nikhil gave a birds eye view of Indian Institute of Science starting from its inception to the present day with supporting photographs. He opened up the avenues of graduate, integrated PhD and PhD programs of the Institute and stressed upon the problem solving approach is of immense importance. He mentioned that Lot of opportunities in the area of Artificial Intelligence is opening up in biology. Students raised many questions and the interaction took place for more than an hour.

This workshop is completed successfully with 238 participants and 235 Post graduate and graduate students getting the benefit.

RUNNING WITH ANTS

Speaker: Prof. Sumana Annagiri
Professor, IISER-Kolkata

In this talk, I will be giving a glimpse into the lives of ants with a particular focus on the challenges of finding and moving into a new dwelling. Colony relocation is an important component in the life history of organisms and it directly impacts the survival and fitness, but very little is known about it. Recurring hundreds of individuals, carrying stored resources, maintaining the colony cohesion through this process, and navigating across a heterogeneous terrain are some of the challenges that ants would be facing. Using a combination of controlled lab-based experiments and field-based explorations we delineate the intricate behavioural responses of the model organism – *Diacamma indicum* to these problems.
