We are pleased to inform you that the Graduate Program Committee has accepted your application for admission to the Pharmacology and Neuroscience Graduate Program. This decision is subject to a final determination and official offer to be made by the Graduate School in Carbondale. Should you choose to accept, your graduate education will be funded by a monthly stipend, which includes a tuition waiver, effective Fall 2019 Semester. We commit to funding students with stipends through the completion of our program, as long as individuals remain in good standing with the graduate college. This funding is a research assistantship. Stipends support students during their coursework and to perform research in accordance with program requirements. The current *monthly* stipend is \$1,739.50. Students are responsible for the following fees, current as of today, but subject to change:

If you choose to accept this offer, you will then receive an official letter from the graduate college office. **The fellowship offer is contingent upon your acceptance within 10 days of the official acceptance letter that you will receive from the graduate college.**

The Fall 2019 Semester begins on Monday, August 19, 2019. Please make arrangements to be at the SIU Springfield Campus by August 5, 2019. You will then meet with me for departmental orientation to register for classes.
