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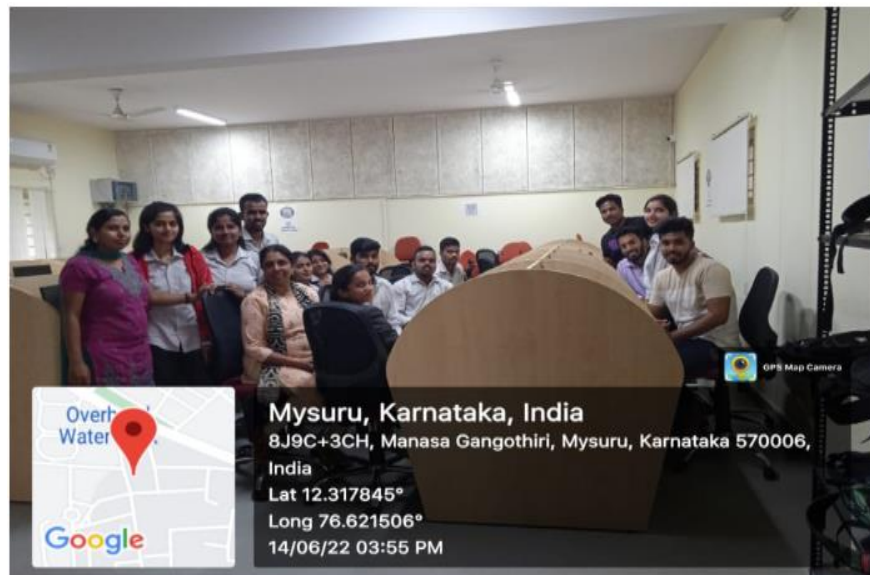
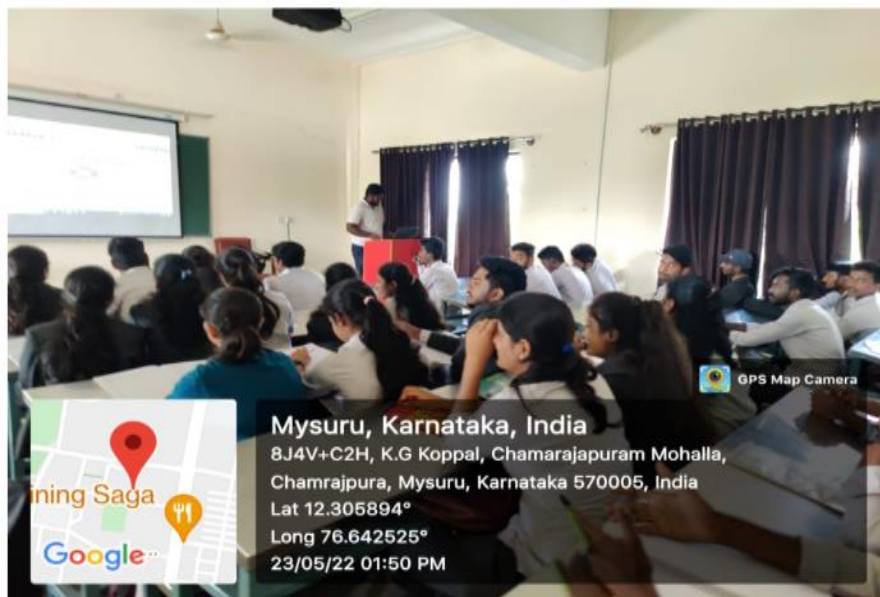

very interesting, Interactive, Informative and students got a platform to experience the BSE stock exchange trading activities.



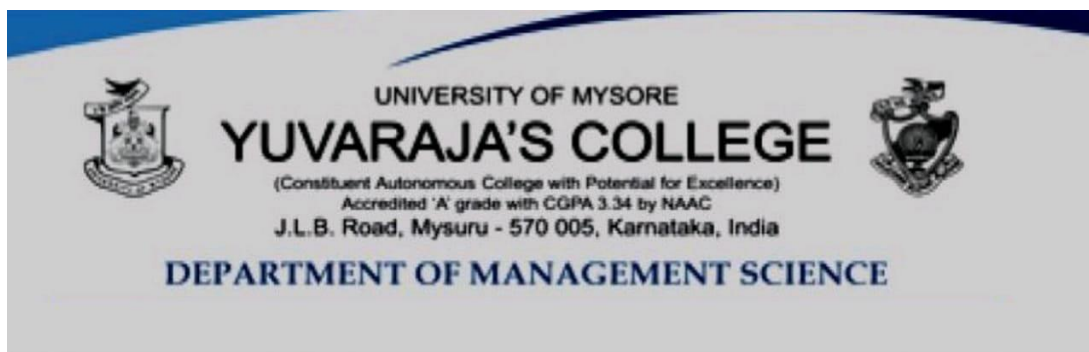
SCHOOL ADOPTION PROGRAM WAS HELD ON 28-01-2022.
