Though NCC India boasts a strong relationship with 11 countries and generally YEP is conducted with all these nations this year due to international lockdown only one nation that is Bangladesh hosted YEP. It is our immense pride that one of our student SCC Aniruddha Rao A represented our nation in Bangladesh as a Youth ambassador which consisted of 1 OIC (Officer in Charge), 1 WTLO and 20 cadets representing all the states of the Nation. And witnessed the Bangladesh's 50 th Victory Day parade at Dhaka, Bangladesh. The exchange program lasted for 12 days in total during which the student witnessed the beauty of Bangladesh visiting places such as their National Museum, National war memorial, Bangabandhu Memorial Museum, HQ of the three-Armed forces, HQ of Bangladesh NCC, Bangladesh NCC Academy, Cox's Bazar, Chittagong. 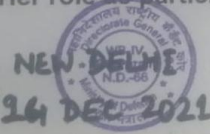

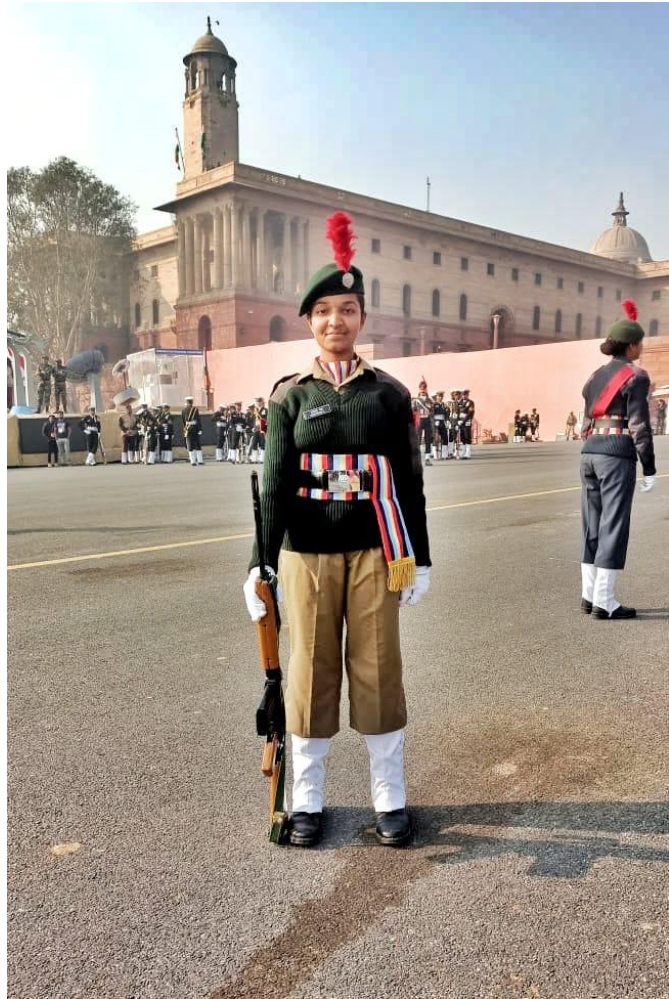
